

2012 Picnic Shelter Reservations

The City of Bloomington provides picnic shelters for reservation to host family gatherings, company picnics, group events, banquets, wedding receptions, class reunions or meetings. The shelters are available from approximately **April through mid-October**. The shelters are located in parks that provide numerous amenities including playground equipment, walking trails, and sports facilities. All shelter areas have electricity, restrooms, grills, picnic tables and drinking fountains.

Reservations are available on a first-come, first serve basis beginning January 3, 2012. To reserve a shelter, completely fill out and return the Picnic Shelter Reservation Form to the Parks and Recreation Division. Upon receipt of your Reservation Form, City staff will create a permit for your event. This permit is the official documentation of your reservation. Once you receive the permit, you are required to sign and return the permit with reservation fee to the Parks and Recreation Division within 10 days. If the permit and reservation fee are not returned within this 10 day period, your reservation will be cancelled.

Bush Lake Shelters

WHAT IF IT RAINS THE DAY OF OUR EVENT?

The City may cancel your reservation for safety reasons due to inclement weather. If the City makes this determination, you may reschedule your event for an alternate date or receive a refund. Refunds will not be issued if you decide to cancel your event without approval by the City.

WHEN IS THE RESERVATION FEE DUE?

The reservation fee is due within 10 days of receipt of permit. If the permit and reservation fee are not received within ten days, the reservation will be automatically cancelled.

WHAT IS YOUR CANCELLATION POLICY?

Reservation fees are not refundable if cancellation is made less than 14 days prior to use date. A \$25 cancellation fee will be retained for all cancellations made 14 days or more in advance of the use date. If arrangements must be changed or cancelled, contact the Parks and Recreation Division at 952-563-8877 at least two weeks in advance.

WHAT IF MY GROUP IS TAX EXEMPT?

You must provide a copy of your tax exempt certificate at the time of reservation. We will retain a copy of your tax exempt certificate in our office.

IS SPORTING EQUIPMENT AVAILABLE?

Limited equipment is available free of charge but with a deposit. Volleyballs, horseshoes, bats and balls are available. Please call the Parks and Recreation Division to reserve equipment.

If you have questions or need assistance the day of your event, feel free to contact the attendant at the phone number on your permit. If you need emergency help, please dial 911.

DO I NEED ADDITIONAL PERMITS TO USE THE PARK?

Temporary Conditional Use permits are required for moonwalks, dunk tanks, tents, pony rides, inflatables, etc. A food or beverage license is required if you sell or serve to the general public (not your invited guests). If you have specific questions about permits, please contact the Parks and Recreation Division.

CAN I USE ANY CATERER?

Yes, but we suggest you use a *licensed caterer* for your event.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

- No alcoholic beverages, except 3.2 malt liquor, are allowed in designated picnic areas.
- No glass bottles or containers allowed in the parks.
- A food/beverage license is required if food will be sold or served to the public.
- Pony rides, moonwalks, tents, etc. require a Temporary Conditional Use Permit.
- No person shall use tobacco products on any City-owned parks.

PLEASE CONTACT PARKS AND RECREATION WITH ANY QUESTIONS REGARDING CITY CODES.

SHOULD I BRING MY PERMIT TO THE PARK THE DAY OF MY EVENT?

Yes! The permit acts as your receipt and will eliminate any confusion during your reservation. Please note that your reservation does not grant your group exclusive use of the entire park.

GARBAGE AND RECYCLING CANS?

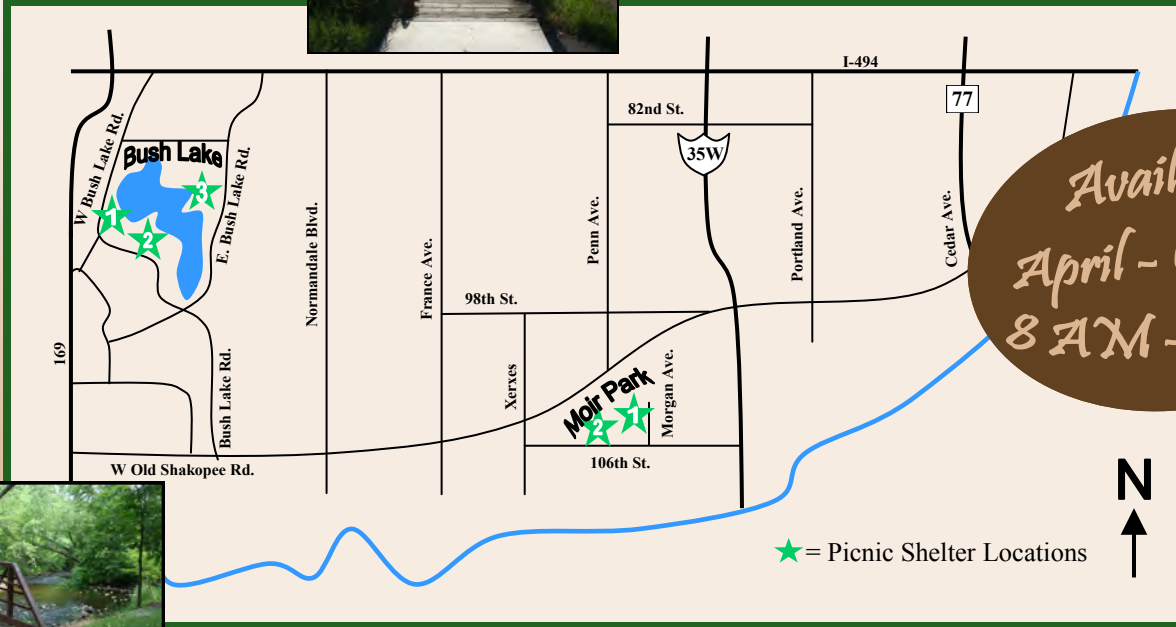
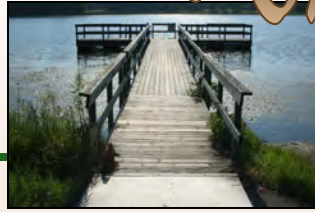
Sufficient garbage and recycling cans are provided at each park. Park staff will empty the garbage and recycling cans as needed.

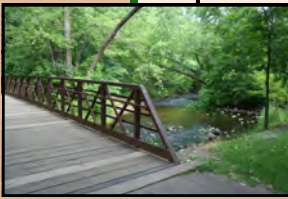
