The engineering division invites you to the open house between 5:00 -7:00 p.m for information about the 84th Street Area Improvements. We encourage you to take advantage of this opportunity to provide input on this project.

What's being proposed?

- Metropolitan Council Environmental Services lift station and sanitary sewer improvements
- Improvements to Stanley Road and its intersection with 84th Street
- Intersection improvements to France Avenue and 84th Street
- Possible neighborhood entry treatments

What happens at the meeting?

At the Open House information will be provided about the proposed changes to the sanitary sewer and roadways. Displays will be available illustrating the various components of the project. The project includes more than just the traffic changes you have seen at previous meetings. Staff will be available to answer questions regarding the project and the proposed changes.

Will I be assessed?

No, the project is being funded from a variety of sources, including MCES and Bloomington utility funds. There will be no assessments to the property owners along the corridor.
