

Poplar Bridge Neighborhood Traffic Study Comment Card
March 24, 2008 Open House

At the January open house, information was presented that identified delays on I-494 and arterial roadways are encouraging drivers to seek alternative paths on streets in the Poplar Bridge neighborhood. Several generalized concepts were presented as possible solutions to reduce cut-through traffic and speeding. Comments received at the last open house indicated support for the general concept of neighborhood diverters. Other concerns were raised regarding access and safety along West 84th Street. The Poplar Bridge Study Advisory Committee (SAC) has used this information to prepare alternative concepts to address neighborhood concerns and would appreciate additional feedback based on the information presented tonight.
