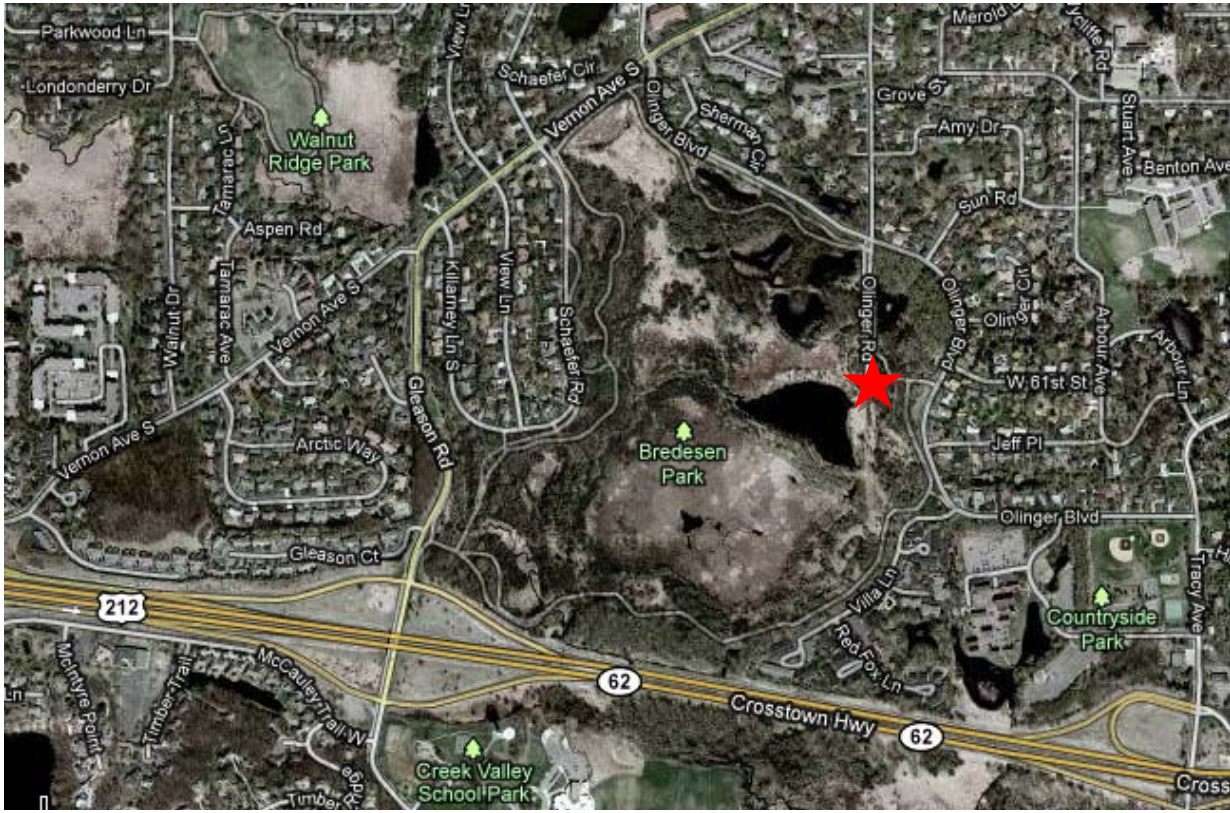

Did you know?

Bottled water is up to 1000 times more expensive than tap water; to produce 1 gallon of bottle water, it takes 7 gallon of tap water. Plastic bottles also use raw materials and limited fossil fuels to be manufactured and distributed. Only 10% of plastic bottles are recycled in the US. Tap water is regularly tested and does not create any health risks.
